Oakvillegreen takes care of all the advertising and coordination to make sure the day is a success.

Several community groups have taken advantage of the Community Garage Sale in the past three years to make money for their organization. It's a no fuss, no stress way for community groups to raise money. Individuals are also welcome to participate in the sale. It's a great way to turn unused items into cash and clean out overcrowded garages and basements.

This year's sale will be held on Saturday, May 29, at the Oakville Town Hall parking lot, 1225 Trafalgar Road. Vendors will set up from 7 to 7:45 a.m. and sales to the public will begin at 8 a.m. and wrap-up by noon.
